Old Testament **Deuteronomy 5:12-15 CSB**

¹² Be careful to remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy as the Lord your God has commanded you. ¹³ You are to labor six days and do all your work, ¹⁴ but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God. Do not do any work—you, your son or daughter, your male or female slave, your ox or donkey, any of your livestock, or the resident alien who lives within your city gates, so that your male and female slaves may rest as you do. ¹⁵ Remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the Lord your God brought you out of there with a strong hand and an outstretched arm. That is why the Lord your God has commanded you to keep the Sabbath day.

Lord of the Sabbath

²³ And it happened that He was passing through the grainfields on the Sabbath, and His disciples began to make their way along while picking the heads *of grain*. ²⁴ And the Pharisees were saying to Him, “Look, why are they doing what is not lawful on the Sabbath?” ²⁵ And He said to them, “Have you never read what David did when he was in need and he and his companions became hungry; ²⁶ how he entered the house of God around the time of Abiathar the high priest, and ate the consecrated bread, which is not lawful for *anyone* to eat except the priests, and he also gave it to those who were with him?” ²⁷ And Jesus was saying to them, “The Sabbath was made for man, and not man for the Sabbath. ²⁸ Consequently the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath.”

Jesus Heals a Man on the Sabbath

3 And He entered again into a synagogue; and a man was there with a withered hand. ² And they were watching Him *to see* if He would heal him on the Sabbath, so that they might accuse Him. ³ And He said to the man with the withered hand, “Get up and come forward!” ⁴ And He said to them, “Is it lawful to do good or to do harm on the Sabbath, to save a life or to kill?” But they kept silent. ⁵ And after looking around at them with anger, grieved at their hardness of heart, He said to the man, “Stretch out your hand.” And he stretched it out, and his hand was restored. ⁶ And the Pharisees went out and immediately *began* taking counsel together with the Herodians against Him, *as to* how they might destroy Him.
